

SETTLE THE STRIKE! OUR DEMANDS:

The Blocks, the owners of the Post-Gazette, must follow a federal court order and reinstate the collectively bargained health insurance plan that they illegally ripped away from Guild members.

The Blocks must reinstate the terms of the previous collectively bargained contract, which include the health insurance plan, a restoration of the short-term disability plan and a guaranteed 40-hour workweek, among other terms.

The Blocks must end their illegally declared impasse to contract negotiations.

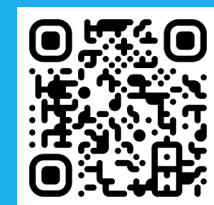

WHY WE ARE STRIKING!

A FAIR CONTRACT

Guild members haven't received an across-the-board raise since 2006 and have been working without a contract since 2017. We are ready to bargain, but the Blocks have refused to negotiate new terms in good faith.

We demand the Blocks meet us at the bargaining table and negotiate a fair contract!

AN END TO UNFAIR WORKING CONDITIONS

In 2020, at the height of the pandemic, the Blocks illegally declared an impasse in negotiations and unilaterally imposed new work rules. The company lowered wages, forced a worse health care plan onto workers, reduced benefits including short-term disability, and stripped away years of bargained protections concerning overtime and newsroom jurisdiction.

We demand the Blocks end their illegal impasse!

HEALTH CARE

In March 2025, the federal Third Circuit court found the Post-Gazette to have broken the law so egregiously that the court issued a rare 10(e) emergency injunction that ordered them to reinstate the collectively bargained health insurance plan.

We demand the Blocks restore our health insurance!



VICTORY IS WITHIN SIGHT!

The Post-Gazette has continued to waste money on out-of-town union-busting lawyers rather than settle the strike with their workers.

The National Labor Relations Board has ruled that the company has over and over again broken labor law, to the point where they will be facing federal contempt of court charges.

This means that the company could face substantial fines and see their assets frozen.
